Title: Request for p-ANI Assignment Information – p-ANI Assignors

This notice only applies to those entities that have assigned non-dialable p-ANIs (Pseudo Automatic Number Identification) out of the 211 NXX or 511 NXX.

As a follow up to the notice sent on 6/20/2011, announcing that the FCC approved Neustar's Change Order Proposal #19 regarding implementation of the permanent Routing Number Administrator (RNA) function on 6/17/2011, we are now requesting that any entity that has assigned any non-dialable p-ANIs (*out of the 211 NXX or 511 NXX*) report on the assignments it has made (that the assignors are using or are in the process of activating) using the report (Excel 2007 format) attached to this notice.

The p-ANI inventory will be initially populated with non-dialable p-ANI assignment data received from the existing p-ANI users and cross-referenced with the data from the existing p-ANI assignors before any non-dialable p-ANI is made available for assignment, to assure that no number is considered available for assignment if either a user or an assignor believes that it is in use. Any non-dialable p-ANIs not reported will be considered available by the RNA for placement in its inventory of available p-ANIs to assign from.

In areas that are served by a paired Selective Router architecture, you may use the "Remarks" field provided in the report to identify the second Selective Router.

When naming your file, use the following file naming convention: "**CompanyName.mmddyyyy**", the date should be the date the report is submitted. Please send this report to esqksupport@neustar.biz between **11/01/2011-11/30/2011**.

All assignors will be required to submit a second report between **3/1/2012- 3/9/2012**, of any activity that occurs between when the first report was filed in November and the date the second report was filed.
